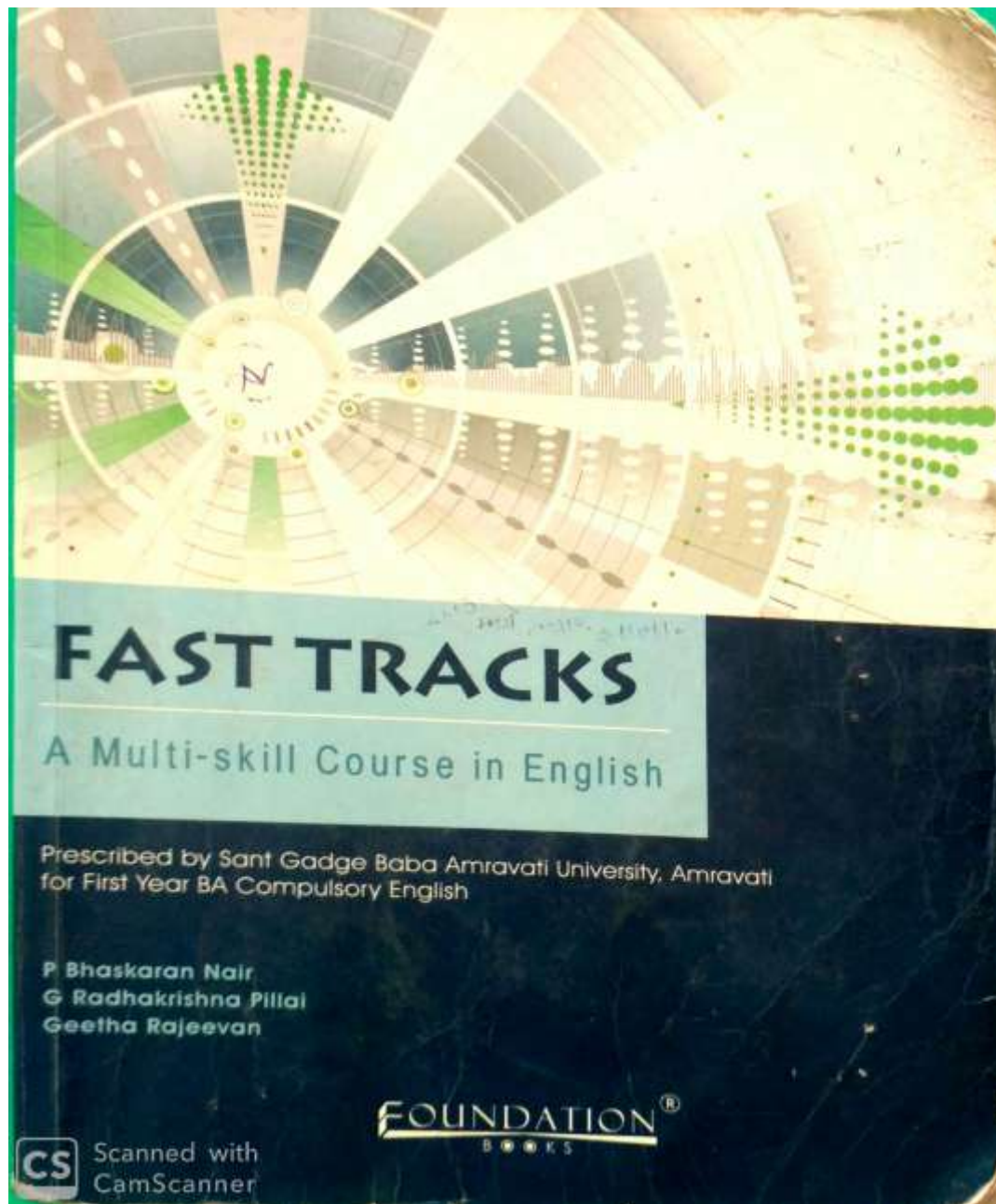

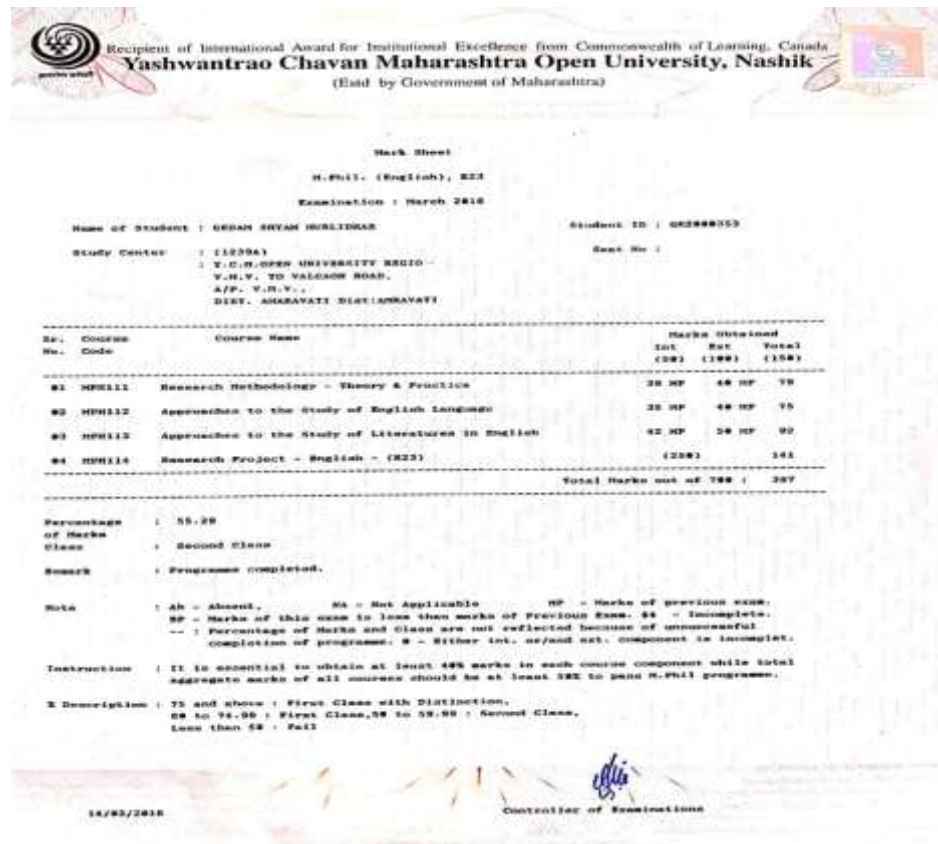

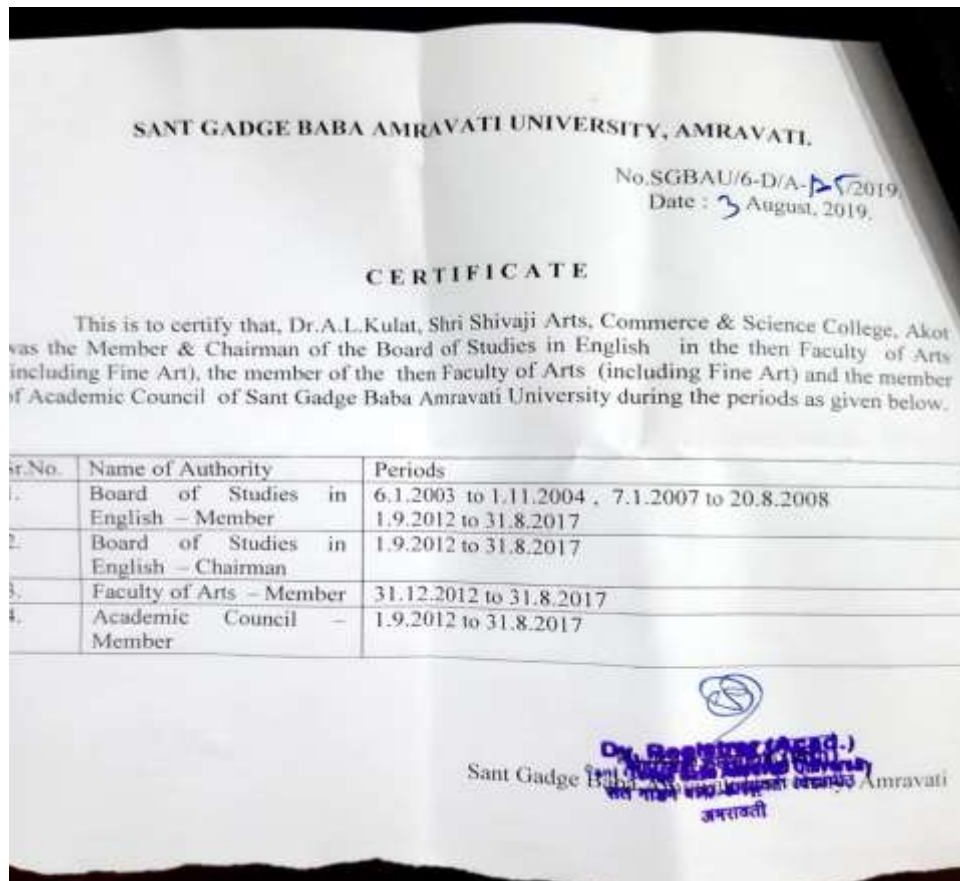

Guest Lecture

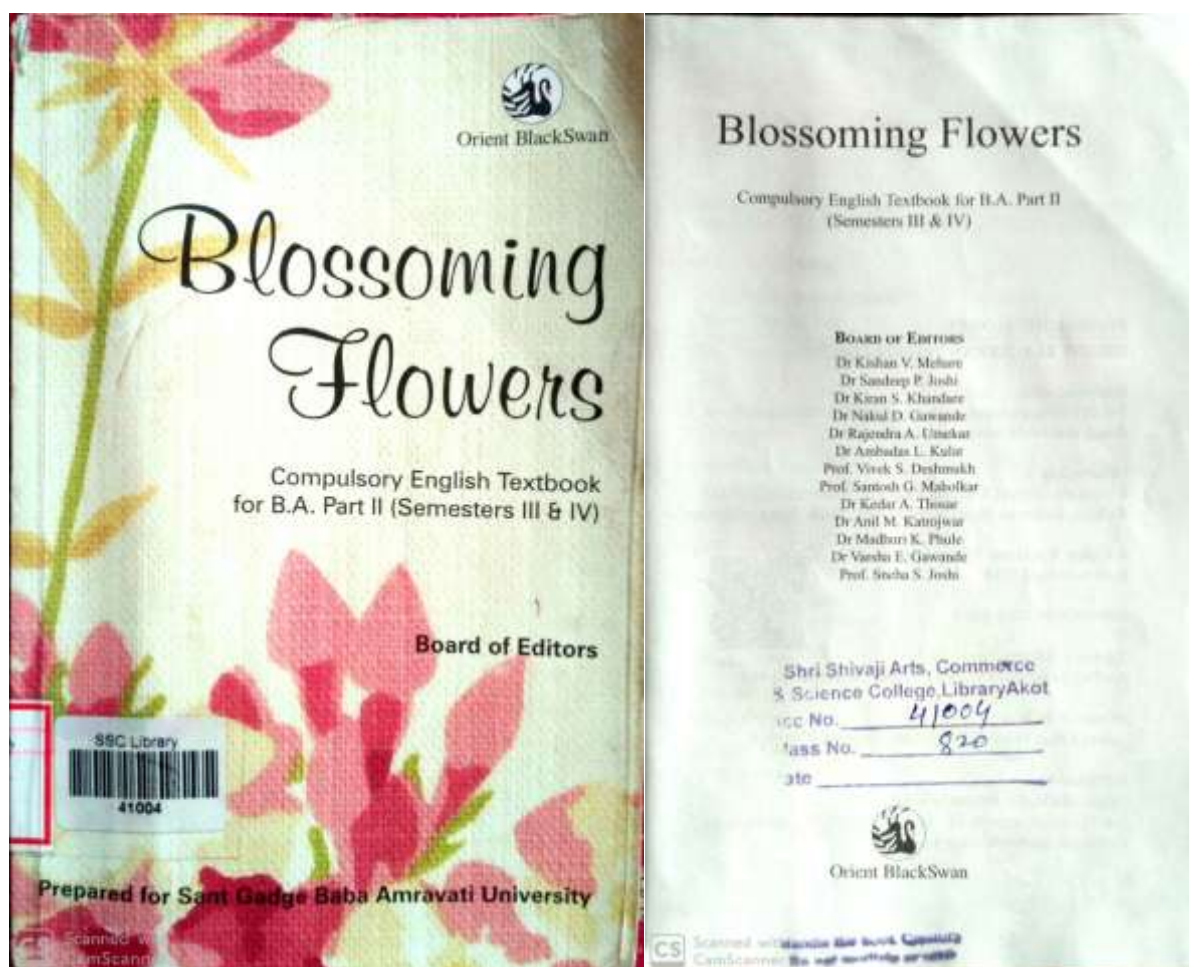

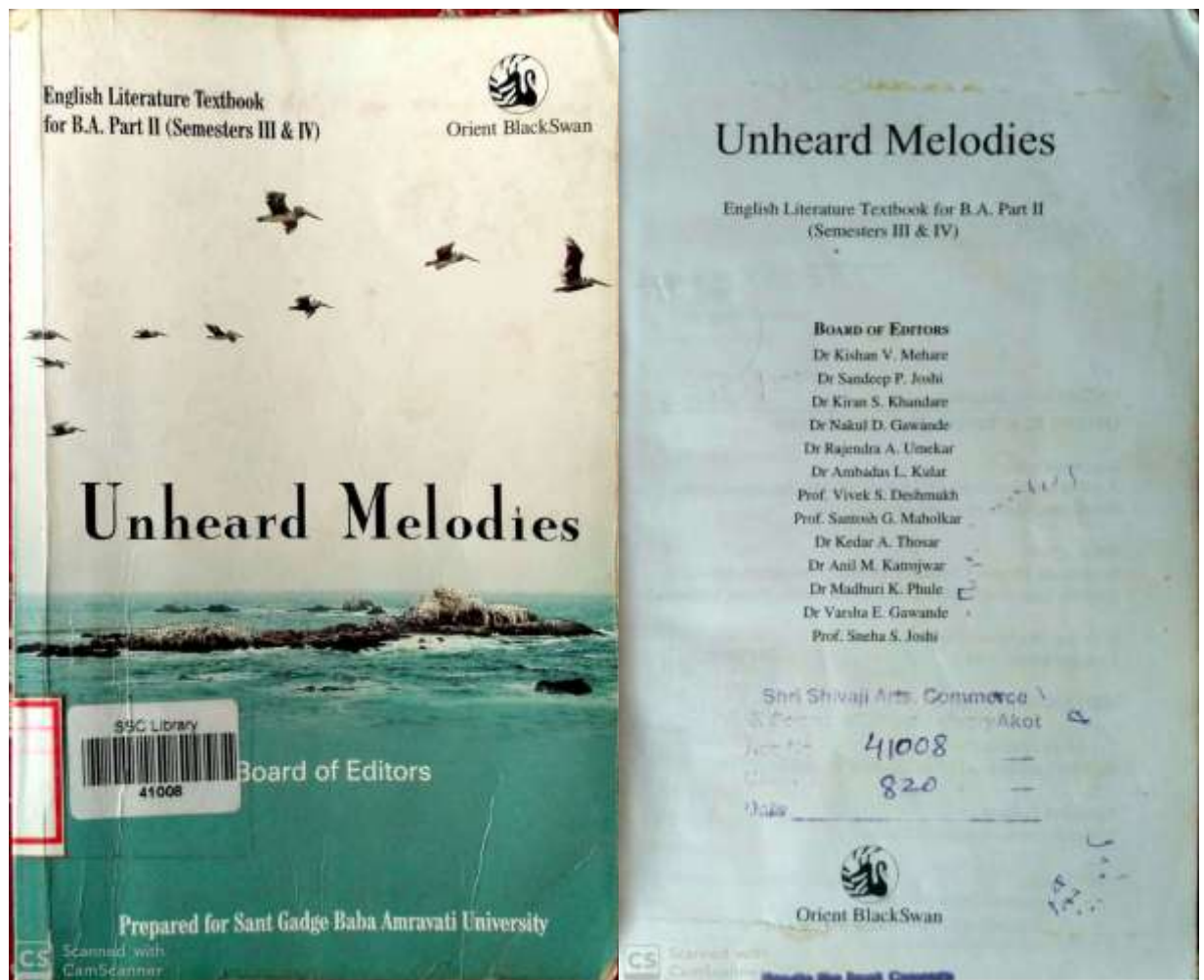

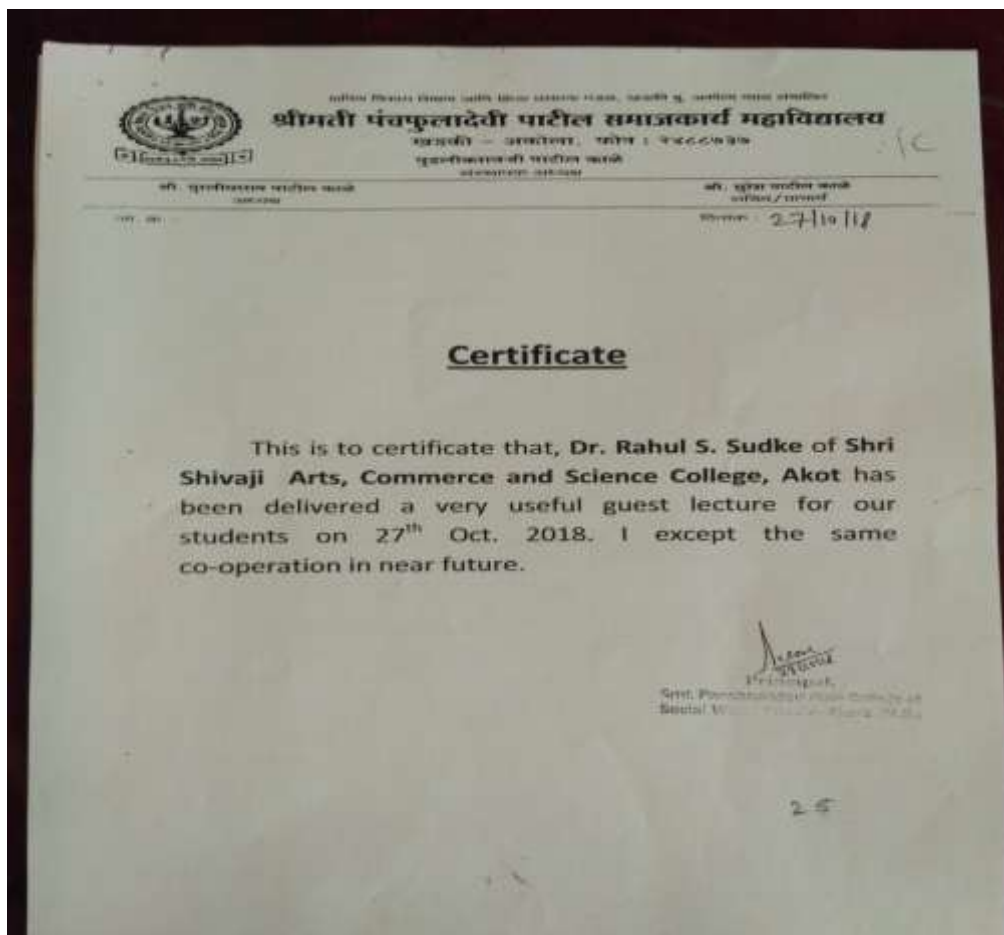
